Parish Council News



At the January 21 Parish Council meeting, the Social Action Committee announced that the refugee family sponsored by the parish is now waiting at a detention camp in Thailand; their arrival in this country has been delayed until June. In a committee reorganization, Gary Laumann will serve as chair and Bob Baessly as recording secretary.

In other committee reports, Education expressed gratitude to over 110 volunteer catechists at their third annual (chili) Appreciation Binner, Worship and Prayer pointed out the need to replace worn liturgical vestments, and Building and Grounds announced plans to replace damaged floor tiles in the main hall and 25-year-old curtains in classrooms and nursery. The Revenue Committee is looking for someone with expertise in bequests and wills to explain practices, methods, and means at a meeting with members.

Father Remm shared with Council members Sister Rosemarie's announcement of her plans to leave St. Patrick's Parish, effective May 31. Sister Rosemarie Tomlianovich, who has served the parish as pastoral associate for six years, will be seeking a position in or near Peoria, where her sister lives. "What I'd really like," she said, with that smile we all know so well and a glint in her eye, "is my own parish. I'm not ready to retire yet!" Although she requested that there be no formal reception in her honor, she admitted to a liking for picnics and ice cream socials, so watch for announcements — she won't slip away unremarked!

Taking up the Social Action Committee's proposal for a six-point program that includes development of two half-time staff positions, Council invited responses and feedback from committees and staff. After discussion, the program was referred back to the committee for dialogue with other committees and staff, with a timetable calling for submission of a proposal to Council in September 1988.

Council members agreed that the budget for FY 1968-89 will include allocations for spirituality development and parish renewal, speakers of national stature, staff inservicing, discretionary funds for the pastor's use (in lieu of the Christmas collection), Christmas bonuses for paid employees and two programs: Respect Life, and Widows and Widowers. The Council also accepted the Revenue Committee's projection of \$287,577 as income from weekly collections for the next fiscal year.

Council members Barb Peckham and Wally LaBerge will head up the Parish Council Election Committee. Their task is to seek candidates for election to the Parish Council to fill vacancies created by four outgoing members: Andrey Brown, George Fahey, Bob Haessly, and Rita Weisiger. The election is scheduled for April 16-17.

The next meeting of the Council will be held at 7:30pm on Thursday, February 18. All parishioners are welcome to attend.
